First order of business is a Public Hearing on the application of SC Manor for a cabaret license. Applicant was absent at this time.

Second Public Hearing on Stormwater Annual Report was presented by John Mirando. He gave a review of the 2013 compliance by the Village. Report is on file at Village Hall.

Public Comment:

- Resident questioned whether fencing around Scudders Pond would remain.

On a motion by Trustee Vogt, seconded by Trustee McGilloway and unanimously approved by those present, the Public Hearing was closed.

The Mayor reported grant monies were received in the amount of \$400,000 for the sewer line from Congressman Israel.
