

**VILLAGE OF SEA CLIFF
BOARD OF TRUSTEES
STORM UPDATE
NOVEMBER 3, 2012**

- DPW SPENT THE FIRST TWO DAYS CLEARING TREES FROM THE STREETS FOR SAFE PASSAGE FOR FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENT
- DPW WHERE THEY COULD IN A SAFE MANNER CLEARED AS MANY TREES FROM WIRES DURING THIS PERIOD
- THIS CLEARING OF TREES ALLOWED LIPA QUICKER ACCESS INTO THE VILLAGE TO BEGIN REPAIR ON PRIMARY AND SECONDARY WIRES
- NORMAL SANITATION PICKUP RESUMED BY THURSDAY, NOV. 1ST. THERE WILL BE AN EXTRA SANITATION PICKUP ON SATURDAY. **NO FOOD WASTE TO BE BROUGHT TO THE VILLAGE YARD IT WILL BE PICKED UP AT THE CURB ON YOUR NORMAL GARBAGE DAY**
- MAYOR, TRUSTEES AND DIRECTOR OF DPW ATTENDED CONFERENCE CALLS WITH LIPA, TWICE DAILY
- THE MAYOR VISITED THE LIPA OUTPOST AT THE GLEN COVE FIREHOUSE AND TRANSMITTED THE VILLAGES INTERNAL REVIEW OF DAMAGED WIRES, POLES AND TRANSFORMERS
- A CREW OF 14 LIPA WORKERS ARE CURRENTLY WORKING IN THE VILLAGE
- THE VILLAGE HAS PUT THESE CREWS UP AT THE FIREHOUSE TO CUT DOWN ON TRAVEL TIME FROM REPUBLIC AIRPORT TO SEA CLIFF. SOME RESIDENTS EVEN PROVIDED MEALS FOR THE CREW
- BUILDING DEPARTMENT ASSESSED HOMES WITH KNOWN AND VISIBLE DAMAGE
- SOME AREA'S WERE TO BE ENERGIZED BY 8:00P.M. ON NOV. 2ND. MORE CIRCUITS WILL BE ENERGIZED AFTER REPAIRS ON SATURDAY PROVIDING POWER TO MORE HOMES AND BUSINESSES AND THE REMAINDER SHORTLY AFTER THAT.
- HOMES WITH SERVICE DROP PROBLEMS NEED TO HIRE THEIR OWN ELECTRICIAN.
- VILLAGE HALL WAS WITHOUT POWER AND VH STAFF WORKED AT DPW. VILLAGE HALL WILL BE BACK IN OPERATION ON MONDAY 11/5/12
