

**NEW RECYCLING COLLECTION PROCEDURES/Updated Recycling Information**  
as of **JULY 2013**

Beginning **July 31, All recyclables will now be picked up only on Wednesday.**

The procedures for curbside recycling have changed, making it easier than ever for residents to recycle.

**NEW CURBSIDE PROCEDURES:**

- Paper can now be placed in a separate recycling container and does not have to be bundled.
- Cardboard boxes no longer need to be crushed. Boxes may be placed inside other boxes.
- Glass, plastic, and metal are still placed in a recycling container; however, excess may be placed in a clear plastic bag.
- Grocery and retail plastic bags labeled with recycling number 2 or 4 may be bundled separately and left for recycling.
- Additional recycling containers are available at Sea Cliff Village Hall for \$17, or at local hardware stores.

*Please rinse out food containers. Labels and caps do NOT need to be removed.*

**PLASTIC/GLASS/METAL**

**What to Recycle:**

- ▶ Non-returnable plastic or glass bottles
- ▶ Any container with numbers 1 through 7 in the recycling symbol
- ▶ Metal food cans/aluminum foil/pie tins
- ▶ 6-pack ring carriers
- ▶ Aerosol cans
- ▶ Beverage cartons
- ▶ Plastic pots from plant nurseries
- ▶ Plastic grocery/retail bags (recycle #2 or #4 ONLY); bundle separately.

**What NOT to Recycle:**

- ▶ Returnable bottles should be returned to your local retailer.
- ▶ Styrofoam
- ▶ Windows/sheets of glass/mirrors
- ▶ Cans or bottles that contained pollutants or pesticides
- ▶ Ceramics/porcelain/cookware
- ▶ Plastic wrap and film such as sandwich, garbage and chip bags
- ▶ Plastic toys
- ▶ Light Bulbs (take CFLs to S.T.O.P)
- ▶ Paint cans/paint thinner containers (take to S.T.O.P.)
- ▶ Large metal items. To arrange for pickup, please call 671-0080.

**PAPER/CARDBOARD**

**What to Recycle:**

- ▶ Newspaper/Newsprint Ads
- ▶ Brown paper bags
- ▶ Mixed paper including mail/envelopes/computer paper/phone books
- ▶ Corrugated cardboard boxes
- ▶ Non-corrugated cardboard: cereal boxes, etc.

**What NOT to Recycle:**

- ▶ Single-use items such as paper towels, paper plates and cups, and tissue paper.
- ▶ Gift wrap/ribbon

*Staples do NOT need to be removed.*

**ELECTRONIC RECYCLING**

***Available at the Altamont Ave. Recycling Center, Saturday 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM.***

**What to Recycle:**

- ▶ Computers/monitors/keyboards
- ▶ Cell phones/pagers
- ▶ Printers/copiers/fax machines
- ▶ VCRs/stereos
- ▶ Batteries (please do not dispose of these in the regular trash)

**What NOT to Recycle:**

- ▶ Smoke detectors
- ▶ Explosives/fireworks
