

Bill VSC 1914

A local law to amend the Code of the Village of Sea Cliff, in relation to purchase contracts.

Section one. Findings. Pursuant to General Municipal Law §103(1), the Village is authorized to adopt a local law which would permit the Village to use the “best value” standard in awarding contracts or accepting offers for purchase contracts (including contracts for purchase of services). The Village of Sea Cliff determines that it is in the best interests of the Village that such legislation be enacted and that such standard be used in the Village where appropriate for the award of such contracts.

Section two. The Code of the Village of Sea Cliff is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section, to be section 14-3, to read as follows:

“§ 14-3. Purchase contracts. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Code of the Village of Sea Cliff with respect to purchase contracts (including contracts for purchase of service work), and pursuant to the provisions of General Municipal Law 103(1), the Village of Sea Cliff may award such purchase contracts to a responsive and responsible bidder or offeror on the basis of “best value.”

Section three. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this local law shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or the application of this local law to any person or set of circumstances shall be held invalid, such invalidity or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or operation of this local law directly involved in the controversy in which the judgment shall have been rendered. To further this end, the provisions of this local law are hereby declared to be severable.

Section four. This local law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.
