- Two events just launched the Spring season of senior programming: An intergenerational program: “Exploring our history through the stories of artifacts”, at Sea Cliff Village Museum, and an informational session at the Mutual Concerns senior lunch program on “Health and Home Emergency Preparedness” presented by Sea Cliff Fire Dept and Northwell Health representatives.
- Several local excursions for seniors are being planned for Spring and Summer months; door-to-door free bus transportation will be available. Locations and dates will be posted on Sea Cliff Village website and Facebook page. Join us at Sea Cliff beach for a lunch outing on the pavilion or experience a docent tour of the Nassau County Art Museum.
- St. Francis Outreach Health Bus- will offer free health screenings using their state-of-the-art Outreach Bus. The screenings will include a brief cardiac history, blood pressure, simple blood test for cholesterol, and diabetes screening with patient education and referrals. July 9<sup>th</sup> 10:00am-2:00pm, Roslyn Ave & Glen Ave by St. Luke’s Church, Sea Cliff.
- The Home Energy Assistance program (HEAP) now provides a Cooling Assistance Benefit as of April 15, 2024. If you are eligible, you may receive one Cooling Assistance benefit per applicant household for the purchase and installation of an air conditioner or a fan to help your home stay cool. - Glen Cove Senior Center provides Curb-to-Curb Transportation for seniors in Glen Cove, Glen Head, Glenwood Landing and Sea Cliff. It's free to join and they offer a myriad of programs that support healthy aging, as well as social work services.
- Sea Cliff Village offers free bus transportation for weekly shopping trips on Wednesdays, and a monthly trip to Trader Joe's. Senior Action Committee Volunteers offer free transportation to medical appointments.
