1. 185 Glen Street. Application to replace posts on rear (south) porch.

The Commission has determined not to proceed with landmark designation at this time.

1. The Commission reviewed the tear sheets and drawings in the building department file, and has no issues with the post that the homeowner has selected.
2. Based on the photographs submitted, the porch deck looks higher than what code will permit without a railing. As such, it appears that a railing will be required, and we noted that no drawings/details for a railing were submitted;
3. We note that the applicant seeks approval to use the proposed post on the front porch. Again, we have no objection to the post, but no details concerning the railings were submitted.

Although not part of the application, we wondered whether the homeowner was planning to open up or otherwise treat the bricked up window.

2. Village Survey: Status

1. Naomi Curtis reported that Kelly has completed her work for the summer. She has also downloaded to disks the following material:
